What do Phil Collins, Dave Grohl, Nick D'Virgilio, Sheila E., and Levon Helm have in common? They belong to the unusual category of musicians known as singing drummers. The same applies to **KLAWUTA**. The multi-instrumentalist usually writes and plays all parts of his songs himself, including the vocals.

In his new single "**Manus**" (aptly Latin for "hand"), he really lets loose on his favorite instruments: drums, bass, guitar, and piano. In addition, polyrhythmic elements come into play. For KLAWUTA, however, this is absolutely not about musical showboating—quite the opposite. Song and emotion are always at the center. The lyrics often leave plenty of room for interpretation, as in the line, "Spread into fog, shot into mud." The ambiguity of the content is

a conscious decision, allowing listeners to find themselves and their own stories within the text. KLAWUTA's personal intention takes a back seat. "No, this isn't something you wanna know." Perhaps that's for the best, as something dark seems to be lurking beneath the lyrics.



Multi-instrumentalist and songwriter Matthias Fröhlich (drummer for the alt-prog band LAUSCH, former mastermind behind SERGEANT PLUCK HIMSELF, and a professional photographer by trade) has been releasing music as Klawuta since 2021.

He is driven, in a positive connotation. The concept behind Klawuta is simple: it is a homecoming. Home is his own studio, where songs are written and recorded.
